Our Learning This Half Term

Our new Topic is 'TITANIC'! Within This Topic, we shall explore a time-line of key events and will carry out map work to find out about the ship's voyage. We shall read both fiction and non-fiction books relating to the Titanic and will learn about the class system and how this affected passengers on board.

In Science, our unit of learning is 'Materials'. Linking to our Titanic Topic, we will discover which materials are the most waterproof and will investigate sinking and floating. For Art & Design, we shall build our own ships and will consider the suitability of materials that we use. In Maths, we shall focus on the four operations and will also revise fractions and measures. Our Computing focus for this half-term will be spreadsheets and in R.E. lessons we shall be exploring Hinduism.
