Message from Mrs Woods

What a busy start to the new school year! It is so nice to see Longshaw families once again and the children looking extremely smart in their new school uniforms.

I have seen lots of tired faces this morning – I think we are all getting used to the early starts and full days! Despite this, the children have continued to impress me. They have all adapted so well to the new routines and followed these carefully.

Attendance of pupils has also been impressive – I know that there is still much concern about COVID especially now that we are getting into the winter months and children are starting to catch common illnesses such as colds and runny noses. Please remember that if your child has a high temperature (37.8 °C or above), a new persistent cough, or a loss or change of smell / taste then please call NHS 111 and keep your child at home. Please also contact the school office on the first day of absence to let us know the reason.

Please can I remind all parents not to arrive at school too early for morning drop off / end of day collections.
